

Statement of Collaboration between CoPSO & PISCES

CoPSO (Council of Property Search Organisations), the UK industry body representing property search organisations, has issued the following statement in support of the PISCES initiative (Property Information Systems Common Exchange Standard) which develops common data standards allowing the efficient transfer of property-related data.

PISCES members have established an independent non-profit organisation to deliver an industry Standard for property related e-commerce data exchanges. CoPSO is working closely and collaborating with PISCES on this shared area of interest.
